ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

IN RE: INTERMITTANT JAIL SENTENCES

The undersigned Senior Resident Superior Court Judge and Chief District Court Judge of Judicial District 15A enter this Administrative Order pursuant to Governor Roy Cooper declaring a statewide emergency and Chief Justice Cheri Beasley's Administrative Order in response to the Coronavirus COVID-19

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that on March 10, 2020, Governor Cooper declared a state of emergency and recognized that the "NC DHHS recommends for "Mass Gathering Events" that the event organizers, in part: (1) Urge everyone who is sick not to attend, (2) Encourage those who are at high risk, not attend, (3) Find ways to give people more physical space to limit close contact as much as possible, and (4) Encouraged attendees to wash hands frequently.

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that on March 12, 2020 Alamance County Sheriff's Office has restricted visitor access to the Detention Center effective immediately.

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that the undersigned Chief District Court Judge, Bradley Reid Allen, Sr. entered an Administrative Order on March 13, 2020 regarding intermittent jail sentences which provided that intermittent jail sentences/split jail sentences were temporarily suspended until May 1, 2020.

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that on March 27, 2020, Governor Cooper issued a statewide Stay at Home Order beginning Monday, March 30, 2020 at 5:00pm until April 29, 2020.

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that Chief Justice Beasley entered an order on April 2, 2020 postponing court proceedings until June 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Effective immediately Alamance County Superior and District Courts will temporarily suspend intermittent jail sentences/split jail sentences that typically occur on weekends.

- 2. Probation and Parole Officers shall reschedule any intermittent jail sentences/split sentences and not schedule any such sentences until after July 1, 2020.
- 3. This order shall remain in effect until July 1, 2020 unless modified or terminated.
